COLLECTION of POA ASSESSMENTS POLICY

I, Lynda Hudgins, President of Hide-A-Way on the Gulf Property Owners Association, Incorporated (the "Association"), do hereby certify that at the meeting of the Board of Directors of the Association (the "Board") duly called and held on the 28th day of 2023, with at least a quorum of the board members being present and remaining throughout, and being duly authorized to transact business, the following Collection and Fines of overdue POA dues was duly approved by a majority vote of the members of the Board:

RECITALS:

- 1. Section 209 of the Texas Property Code was amended to add Section 209.006 granting property owners' associations the right to suspend privileges of a property owner not in compliance with all Property Owners Association Restrictions, Covenants, and Conditions, by-laws, and policies.
- 2. The Board of Directors of the Association desires to adopt a Collection of Assessments, Fees, and Fines Policy for unpaid POA dues, Fees, and unpaid fines, consistent with the law.
- 3. The Common Areas consist of the recreational area inside the fences, the pool, clubhouse, the area in and around the common mailboxes, the boat ramp, and smaller miscellaneous spaces. These recreational areas are for the use of property owners and their invited guests.
- 4. Fourth Amended Restrictions, Covenants and Conditions sec IV titled "The Associations and Assessments"
 - 4.02 The power shall include the power to levy fines, which shall become part of the maintenance fee to which each lot is subject and secured by the lien and subject to all remedies for the enforcement thereof.

POLICY:

1. Collection of Property Owners Assessments/Dues:

- POA assessments/dues are per lot as platted on the original plat dated. The dues/assessments for each "lot" owned shall be \$200.00 annually per lot.
- The assessments are due January 1 and are delinquent on February 1.

2. Returned Checks:

• Return Check Charges: In addition to all charges imposed under the Association Bylaws or Policies, a fee equal to the amount charged to POA will be assessed against the owner in the event the check or other instrument payable for the benefit of such Owner is not honored by the bank or is returned for any reason whatsoever, including but not limited to insufficient funds.

3. Collecting late Assessments Fees or Fines:

 All costs associated with collecting delinquent assessments including fines, interest, POA Attorney's fees and late fees will be the responsibility of the delinquent property owner.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Property Association Owners with past due assessments will be notified by the POA Board. The notifications shall include (i) a description of the violation or late payment, (ii) the amount owed by the homeowner to the Association. (iii) the reasonable time allowed owner to cover nonpayment by association, (iv) The rights the owner has to a formal hearing with the board to discuss the facts of the case, per Sec. 209.007 of the Texas property code.
 - First notification by letter by first class mail.
 - Second notification by first class letter and certified mail 30 days after 1st letter.
 - Third notification by first class letter and register letter 30 days after 2nd letter.
- 2. If the balance, including late fees, accrued interest, costs of collections, and fines, is not paid in full within 30 days or a payment plan established and agreed to by the POA board.
 - The property owner, including all family members and guests, will have the use of all Common Areas suspended. (Swimming Pool, Boat Ramp and Club House)
 - Property owners who default on the payment plan agreement will have the use of all Common Areas suspended.

- Suspended property owners who continue to use the Common Areas after suspension will be **prosecuted for trespassing**.
- 3. The late fee for overdue assessments is \$50 for each month that any remaining balance of the Assessments or late fees are overdue. Late fees shall continue to be applied monthly, on the first of each month until the balance for assessments is paid in full.
- 4. The Board may take property owners delinquent in payment to court for judgment 30 days after the third letter is sent.
 - The POA has the right by law for judgment for monetary payment.
 - The POA also has the right to put a lien on the property for all assessments owed.
- 5. Hearing before the Board:
 - The board must have a written request by certified mail for any requested hearing on any assessments dispute. Mail to 503 Anchor Dr. Freeport, TX 77541
- 6. Paying off delinquent assessments:
 - The minimum time the board can ask for full payment of assessments is three months.
 - The POA may not allow a payment plan for any amount that extends more than 18 months from the date of the owner's request for a payment plan. Payment plans are not available for current assessments and overdue assessments that exceed \$1000. The availability of any payment plan is at the sole discretion of the POA board.
- 7. Priority of payments.
 - Fines and late fees first
 - · Attorney's fees paid second
 - Delinquent assessments paid third
 - Current assessments paid last

I hereby certify that I am the duly elected, qualified and acting President of the Association and that the foregoing Common Areas Policy was approved by a majority vote of the Board of Directors as set forth above and now appears in the books and records of the Association, to be effective upon recording in the Official public Records of Real Property of Brazoria County, Texas.
